I wish to apply for permission for my fiancée, Laura Philinda Jones, to enter Nigeria for residence. It is our intention to be married immediately upon her arrival.

Miss Jones is an American citizen, and a passport for the journey has already been issued to her. We are now trying to arrange her transportation by a reasonably safe means. Her address in the United States is:

This is near New York, and, if possible, I would like to have the authorization for the issuance of the visa, if granted, sent to the Passport Control Officer in that city. However, it would not be difficult for her to send her passport to Washington or go in person if necessary. I would like to be permitted to pay for notification by cable.

Since it is not certain exactly how my fiancée will travel, I would appreciate it if her passport could be visaed also for the Gambia, Sierra Leone and the Gold Coast in transit to Nigeria.
