For Jester from Krieg "Regarding Jones transportation, Pan American informs me they have five planes every two weeks from Lisbon to Fisherman's Lake. Space is probably more easily available this way than direct from the United States. I have advised her to proceed to Lisbon by sea if the Department can assure air transportation from Lisbon. I would appreciate your investigating this point and advising her accordingly

In any case she should have written evidence of official status to insure transportation by air transport Command from Fish Lake to Lagos"
