

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Conventions

Abbreviations

C: consonant; **C₁:** first consonant of a word; **C₂:** second consonant of a word

IPA: International Phonetic Alphabet

NN: Nwehu Nuswei

V: vowel; **V₁, V₂**, etc.

~ (tilde) after a word indicates tentative vocabulary assignment

Typography

Words used to describe features of the NN language are shown in **SMALL CAPS** if their definition is specific to NN.

When NN is written in roman letters, it is shown in *italics*.

Glosses (meanings of words) are enclosed in 'single quotes'

IPA transcriptions enclosed in /slants/ are phonemic; in [brackets] are phonetic

Chapters are divided into “sections” with references using the symbol § as in §1.2.3

Charts, tables, diagrams and illustrations are all called “Displays” with references using the symbol D_P as in $D_P1.2$

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
